## Levels

(1) Local Level,	Date: To Be Announced	Location: To Be Announced
(2) Regional Level	Date: March 7, 2020	Location: Dubai - UAE
(3) International Level	Date: Sept 10, 2020	Location: Tokyo - Japan

## Travel Arrangements:

Each team is required to make its own travel arrangements.

## Objective:

- (1) Encourage accounting majors to develop analytics skills
- (2) Develop skills in working with team members

## Participants:

Each university can nominate a team of three accounting undergraduate students to participate. Each team will be led by a professor, who will be the main contact for the team.

## Pre-Competition Training

For student groups with limited experience with audit analytics, we offer online training session in ACL (Galvanize) before the competition.

**Deliverables:** Each team will solve six audit objectives in four hours

**Judges:** There will be three professional judges (Onsite/Online).

## Prize for each group:

- (1) Cash prize: \$1,000 for the 1st place team
- (2) Ranking scheme will be based on the number of the earliest solved problems

## Tool:

- (1) Teams can use any Computer Assisted Audit Tools e.g., ACL (Galvanize)
- (2) It is open resources contest
